Many opportunities exist for Benton County residents interested in volunteering to serve our community by being an active member in advisory boards and committees. Applications are held for one year. Many members' terms end in June or December, at which time vacancies often occur. Advertisements appear on the website and in local newspapers for vacant positions in the fall and spring.

Due to the policy of maximum citizen involvement, persons shall only serve on 1 committee at a time, unless the position requires service on another committee concurrently.

Your application will be submitted to the Alsea Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC). At a public meeting of the Alsea CAC on July 1, 2024 from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m., at the Alsea Public Library. Meeting attendees will vote on new members and then send recommendations to the Benton County Board of Commissioners for approval.
