

# MEETING MINUTES Benton County Planning Commission November 19, 2024

#### I. CALL TO ORDER

Benton County Planning Commission Chair Fowler called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. The meeting was open to the public virtually via a published Zoom link.

#### II. MINUTES

Commissioner Lee **MOVED** to **APPROVE** the October 1, 2024 Minutes. Commissioner Wilson: **SECONDED**. **Motion carried, 6-0.** 

#### III. COMPREHENSIVE PLAN & DEVELOPMENT CODE UPDATE

- **Shannon Bush's Absence**: Schuetz provided the update. Fowler emphasized the need for clear outreach connections.
- Data & Outreach: Focus on including underrepresented communities and addressing access barriers, especially in rural areas.
- **Community Engagement**: Concerns about outreach to both incorporated and unincorporated communities. Tailoring outreach to different groups discussed.

## STAFF

Petra Schuetz, Interim Director and Planning Official Amanda Makepeace, Recorder

- **Granularity of Outreach**: Need for both broad and detailed approaches to ensure effective engagement.
- **Budget & Constraints**: Outreach budget limited to \$75,000.
- Language Feedback: Concerns about the term "stakeholder"; alternatives like "priority populations" suggested.
- **Process & Timeline**: Need for transparency in the outreach process.
- **Development Code Revisions**: Updates on state legislation (HB2727) and UGB planning workshop.
- **Budget & Next Steps**: Push to include the Comprehensive Plan in the county's budget. Lee expressed concerns about affordable housing.
- Outreach Tools: Emphasis on rural community engagement and diverse outreach methods (train the trainer, face-to-face, digital).
- Next Meeting: Joint meeting on December 3, 2024, about UGB expansion.

### IV. PLANNING COMMISSIONER | STAFF UPDATES

- Wilson's Update: Wilson to join Adair Village City Council in January 2025, potentially affecting PC attendance.
- **Fulford Update:** Regional Housing Subcommittee outreach discussed. Next step is BOC goal setting discussion in December.
- **Republic Services Application**: 30-day completeness review period ends December 3, 2024; if deemed complete, Planning Commission review could begin in February.
- Wilson's Question: Inquired about CUP process; Schuetz clarified staff's role in recommendations.
- Appeal Update: St. Martin's CUP decision (LU-23-051) appealed to LUBA. Appeal process could take months.
