

MEETING MINUTES Benton County Planning Commission May 8th, 2025 Public Hearing 6:00-9:00 P.M.

I. CALL TO ORDER | ROLL CALL

Chair Fowler

Benton County Planning Commission Chair Fowler called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. This meeting was a **continuation of the April 29, May 1, and May 6, 2025 public hearing for LU-24-027, Coffin Butte Landfill Expansion**. The meeting was open to the public in person and via a published Zoom link. Chair Fowler confirmed a full quorum of the Commission.

II. APPROVE MINUTES

Prior meeting minutes were not reviewed or approved.

III. PUBLIC HEARING: Conditional Use Permit | Coffin Butte Landfill Expansion | LU-24-027

PUBLIC TESTIMONY PROCEDURE

Chair Fowler reviewed the quasi-judicial hearing procedures, applicable criteria, and public testimony rules. This session continued hearing testimony from individuals opposed to the application, followed by the applicant's rebuttal. Time limits of 3 minutes per speaker were enforced, with allowances for time-ceding. Speakers were called in numerical order with an ondeck system to facilitate flow. Written materials were accepted for inclusion in the record.

SUMMARY OF PUBLIC TESTIMONY

Testimony focused primarily on opposition to the proposed landfill expansion. Speakers raised concerns about public safety, fire risk, traffic impacts, environmental contamination, PFAS in leachate, odor, noise, wildlife impacts, and the county's historic record of enforcing conditions of approval.

Several participants presented data from local fire department logs, FOIA requests, and county transportation plans. Others cited prior Benton County reports and personal experience to argue that operational and environmental impacts would be significant and inadequately mitigated. Points raised included the inadequacy of the applicant's traffic impact analysis, potential functional closure of Coffin Butte Road, and broader land use compatibility issues.

Many urged the Planning Commission to deny the application outright; others requested additional time for public review and comment.

REQUESTS & PROCEDURAL NOTES

Multiple participants requested that the public record remain open for an additional 14 days for written submissions.

Some speakers asked that testimony from prior related applications be incorporated into the current record.

DECISIONS

- No deliberations or decisions were made at this session.
- Public hearing to continue at the next scheduled meeting, with the applicant's rebuttal to follow completion of public testimony.
